**Old Business:**

- Magazines
  - In previous meeting, N. Hurteau reported that Overdrive has changed their magazine subscription model. Overdrive has partnered with another magazine vendor, and now there are two different packages (package A and package B) of magazines to choose from. UHLS currently subscribes to 50 magazines, and 32 of those magazines are in package A and 18 magazines are in package B. Unfortunately, the new subscription does not allow for a la cart choices, and packages must be in specific quantities. Also, UHLS current subscribes to 50 magazines at \$15,000. This has also changed to 35 magazines for the same. Therefore, ECAC must decide to 1) recommend a number of magazines to subscribe to and 2) Review the magazine lists, compare usage stats and recommend a new lists of titles to purchase.
